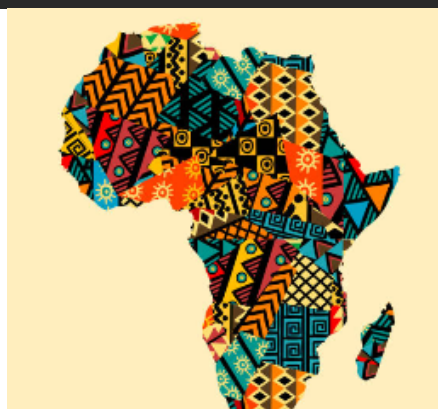

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS ACROSS AFRICA

After undergoing a series of training and mentorship sessions, the OMLA Stars are expected to practice the knowledge they have acquired during the OMLA Fellowship by engaging in Community-Based Projects in their various Localities while the OMLA Fellows supervise them.

In August 2022, OMLA disbursed \$6300 to sponsor 21 projects in 5 African countries which include Gambia, Uganda, Ghana, Nigeria, and Cameroon. The span of executing the community-Based Project is 4 months. Therefore, In the next Newsletter, we are going to share the impact and give an overall of the projects.
